Quote about animals/nature: "It's not about whether animals will survive, it's whether man has the will to save them."

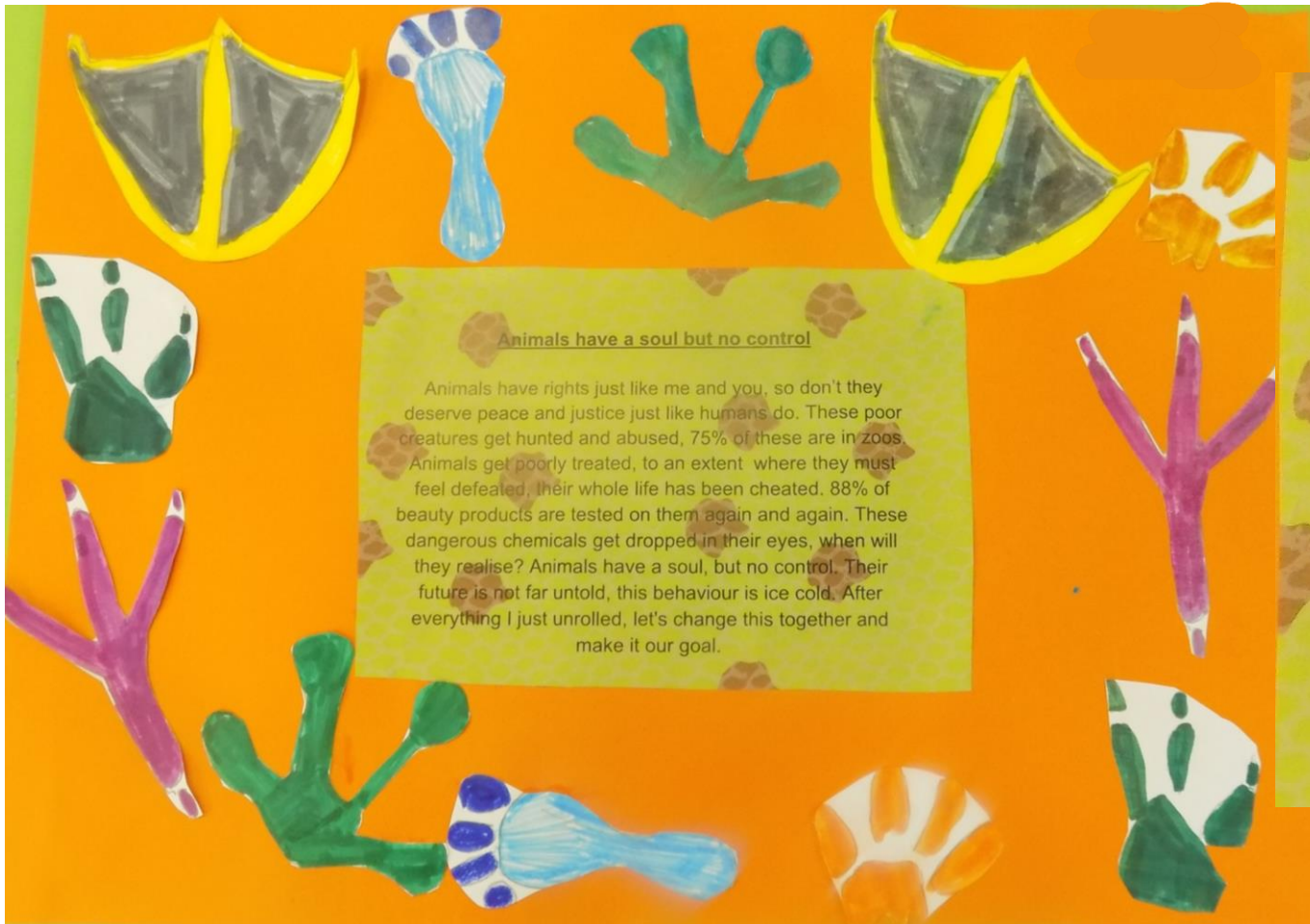
